**EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR COMPANIES
WILLING AND ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GOVERNMENT
ACARICIDES SUBSIDY PROGRAMME FOR 2006/2007
FINANCIAL YEAR**

The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania through the Ministry of Livestock Development has set aside funds to subsidize Acaricide intended to be used in 2006/2007. The subsidy will cover 40% of the agreed price. The types of Acaricide and quantities to be supplied are as follows:

Quantities to be supplied:

- (i) Synthetic Pyrethroids 37,000 lts
- (ii) Amitraz 35,000Lts
- (iii) Organophosphates 18,000Lts

Terms and conditions are as follows:

1. Suppliers must already be in the business and that they are authorised/certified agents of the principal drug manufacturer.
2. Suppliers can apply for supplying subsidized acaricides to one or more of the following zones:
 - (i) Central (Dodoma, Singida, Iringa)
 - (ii) Eastern (Morogoro, Coast, Tanga)
 - (iii) Lake (Mwanza, Shinyanga, Tabora, Kigoma, Mara, Kagera)
 - (iv) Northern (Kilimanjaro, Arusha, Manyara)
 - (v) Southern (Mbeya, Lindi, Rukwa)

NB: Dar es Salaam, Mtwara and Ruvuma Regions are not included in this current programme.

3. The supplier must indicate the type of acaricide to be supplied (i.e. Amitraz, Synthetic Pyrethroids or Organophosphates) and indicate the zone(s) to be supplied.
4. All supplies should be marked on description/product labels "Funded Project by Tanzania Government" and should bear the name and address of the supplier in Tanzania and (NOT STAMPED).

5. Acaricides for subsidy must be registered in Tanzania and should indicate Tropical Pesticide Research Institute (TPRI) registration number.
6. Supplier should incur the cost of importation and transportation of the acaricide to the distributor in the beneficiary Local Government Authority (LGA).
7. The supplier shall sell the acaricide at 60% of the agreed price to the distributor. The remaining 40% will be paid by the government upon submission of coupons endorsed by the beneficiary Local Government Authority.
8. The supplier must have a distributor/agent in the beneficiary Local Government Authority (LGA). Identified distributors/agents should sign a distribution contract with the supplier.
9. Distributor/Agent should be a member of the Local Government Authority (LGA) Acaricides Subsidy Committee to oversee the distribution of subsidized acaricides-
10. Supplier should sign a binding Letter of Agreement with the beneficiary Local Government Authority (LGA).
11. Acaricide for subsidy should have a shelf life of not less than two years valid from date of agreed importation.
12. Suppliers are required to indicate cost per litre for the type of acaricide to be supplied.
13. Successful suppliers shall be required to sign contract with the Ministry of Livestock Development.
14. Successful suppliers must open a letter of credit in a credible Bank within Tanzania.
15. Companies that will meet the above requirements will be short-listed and invited for negotiation and other further steps.

Written expression of interest must be delivered to the address below by 31st January, 2007 before 12 Noon Local time.
